

PRIME MINISTER'S EMPLOYMENT GENERATION PROGRAMME (PMEGP)

The Government of India has launched a credit linked subsidy programme called Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) during 2008-2009 for generation of employment opportunities through establishment of micro enterprises in rural as well as urban areas. The Scheme is being implemented by Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC). State Khadi and Village Industries Boards (KVIBs) and District Industries Centre (DICs).

Eligibility Criteria:

- (1) The maximum cost of the project/unit admissible under manufacturing sector is Rs. 25 lakh and service sector is Rs.10 Lakh.
- (2) Any individual, above 18 years of age, Self Help Groups, Charitable trust, Institutions and Cooperative Societies are eligible for assistance under PMEGP.
- (3) For setting up of project costing above Rs.10 lakh in the manufacturing sector and above Rs. 5 lakh in the service sector, the beneficiaries should possess at least VIII standard pass educational qualification.
- (4) For units setting at Town areas, the units are eligible for sanction of 25% Subsidy towards project cost. For units setting up at Rural areas, the units are eligible for sanction of 35% Subsidy towards project cost.
