



**Social Welfare - Department of Social Defence - implement of
Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2000 as
amended in 2006 - Re-constitution of the Child Welfare
Committee**

ORDER :

In the Government Order List read above the Government have notified the constitution of Eighteen Child Welfare Committees in the State of Tamil Nadu consisting of a Chairman and four Members to each Committee under section 29 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2000. As per the order, the Child Welfare Committee and every Social Worker Chairman and Members appointed to the Committee would hold the office for a period of three years from the date of appointment. The period of chairman and Members to the Eighteen Child Welfare Committees in the Government order read above expired on 31.12.2006.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, it was clarified that as per Rules 15(1) of the Tamil Nadu Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Rules 2001, the existing Chairpersons and Members can continue to hold office till their successors assume charge or for a period of 3 months up to 31.3.2007.

3. In the Government order 3rd, 4th and 5th read above orders were issued continuing existing Chairman and Members of the Committee up to 30.06.2007.

4. Therefore, a Selection Committee of the concerned Districts consisting of the Principal District and Sessions Judge as Chairperson and the District Collector and Commissioner of Police / District Superintendent of Police as members have prepared a panel of names after identifying from the willing and competent persons in the District chosen by them for appointment as Social Worker Chairman and Members to the concerned District Child Welfare Committee in order to fill up the existing vacancies and send the same to Government for appointment by the Government.

5. The Government have examined the proposal in detail. Under section 29 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2000. The Government direct that the following persons mentioned in the (3) of the table below be appointed as Chairman & Members to the Child Welfare Committee.

The tenure eligibility and condition covering for the appointment of Chairman and Members of the Child Welfare Committee are as follows :

1. Every Social Worker / Members of the Committee should hold office for a period of three years from the date of Appointment.

2. The tenure of appointment of Social Worker / Member may be terminated by the State Government at any time : if i) He / She has been found Guilty of misuse of powers vested under this Act.

ii) He / She has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude and such conviction has not been reversed or he / she has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence.

iii) He / She falls to attend the proceedings of the Committee for three

consecutive months without any valid reasons or he / she fails to attend less than three fourth of the sitting in a year.

3. The Committee shall function as a Bench or Magistrates and shall have the powers conferred by the code of Criminal Procedure 1973 (2 of 1974) on a Metropolitan Magistrate or, as the case may be Judicial Magistrate of the I class.

4. Any Member may resign at any time by giving one months advance notice in writing to the State Government

5. This order will take effect from 1.7.2007
